General Competition Expectations

It is expected that a dancer wanting to participate in the competitive program be committed and understand what is expected of them. A lot of extra time, practice and costs are required and must be fully understood before committing to the competitive program. Boundless Dance Studio strongly encourages students to work together as a team, therefore every student will be expected to adhere to the following:

 It is understood that in order to compete you must attend ballet class, stretch class, and the elective classes you have chosen on a <u>REGULAR & CONSISTANT BASIS</u>. If you choose not to attend

> your classes regularly, you will be notified and asked not to participate in the appropriate competitive numbers. Please be considerate and respectful by notifying the studio if you will be absent. All competitive dancers are expected to be in regular classes before and during our competitive season – it is no different than preparing for any other team sports. Please note that regular attendance checks will be made.

- 2. Students and Parents are **required** to:
 - *Fill out & Return Competition Wish List by June 3rd, 2024, with \$25 Registration Fee & \$325.00 Intensive Fee. These fees are non-refundable. Please note late entries may not be given priority.
 - *Fill out, sign and return the Approval Form with Choreography Fees by September 24th, 2024
 - Pay \$60/dancer fee to cover costs for all teachers and staff to be at competition.
 - Pay \$20.00/group dress rehearsal fee by September 21st
 - *Attend Competition Meeting (Saturday, September 14th at 11:00AM BDS)
 - *Attend the MANDATORY studio Summer Intensive Workshop Audition August 20th-22nd- Tuition Due June 3rd, 2024. This will be a three-day workshop.
 - *Attend mandatory dress rehearsals
 - *Attend all three (3) studio competitions. This includes all dances you are chosen for and any
 applicable dance-offs.
 - Possible solo, duo, trio dress rehearsal. To be discussed at meeting.
- 3. Students are required to be in attendance once choreography of group numbers has commenced, through to the conclusion of the competitive season. It is <u>mandatory</u> for all students to be in attendance for the last 2 scheduled competition rehearsals and the week before any studio competition (with the exception of the Studio's closure for Spring Break). *Dancers are only allowed 2 absences from <u>scheduled rehearsals* Please make sure your calendars are up to date</u>. We strongly encourage everyone to work as a team and be considerate to fellow classmates, instructors and staff, as absences can affect your own performance as well as those of other dancers. Please note, action will be taken against dancers not following these rules. Training in regular classes will also be monitored for competitive placement.
- 4. It is the dancer's responsibility to remember choreography to learn and practice any choreography missed due to absences before their next practice. If choreography is forgotten, it may result in a student being pulled from the group number or billed an additional fee of \$50.00/hr for loss of time.

- DETAILS: We will be discussing competition expectations, guidelines, etiquette, dates, etc.

Please bring this notebook with you to this meeting

- To ensure no time is being lost, we ask that all dancers ensure muscles are stretched and warmed up properly for the appropriate competitive number before entering all choreography classes and extra competition lessons. Arrival 15 minutes prior is suggested.
- 6. **Please <u>Note</u>:** Dancers must be involved in the group competition numbers in a specific discipline, to be considered for a solo, duo, trio or small group of that said discipline. (ie: ballet group, then ballet solo/duo etc.

<u>Please keep in mind that participation in the Competitive</u> <u>Programs is a PRIVILEGE</u> and needs to be worked for and earned.....not just expected.

Competition Costs

Choreography Fees*:	
Solos (3 hours)	\$385.00
Duets & Trios (3 hours)	\$210.00
Groups (4-7) (max. 9 hours)	\$185.00

*All fees are per person and include the use of the facilities, choreography, cleaning of the routine and music preparation.

Choreography fees will be invoiced upon completion of the Competition Approval Form and can be made payable to Boundless Dance Studio. <u>All Choreography</u> <u>Fees are due by SEPTEMBER 21st, 2024 and are NON-REFUNDABLE.</u> **No choreography will be started until fees are paid in full**

• Competition Entry Fees:

In order to enter any competition, you must pay an entry fee. As every competition charges different entry fees, we have averaged the costs of the three (3) studio competitions we participated in last year (GST is included in all fees):

Solos \$250.00/solo for all three competitions Duets/Trios \$195.00/dancer for all three competitions Groups \$165.00/dancer for all three competitions

You can expect to pay these amounts for this season pending entry fees stay relatively the same - but entry fees are subject to change

An invoice will be sent out for each individual student. To be entered into a competition by Boundless Dance Studio, you must submit your cheque as requested on your invoice emailed to you. Payments are to be made payable to Boundless Dance Studio and must be returned by the deadline provided.

Prop Fees:

A fee will be charged for props used for competition numbers. The total cost of the props used, would be divided between the participants in the number.

Costume Fees:

The amount set on a solo, duet or trio costume depends on the type of design and cost of the material you choose.

When picking your costume designs and material, <u>you must ensure you have approved</u> everything with the instructor who has choreographed the routine before incurring any costs.

You may choose to have your costumes custom made, ordered from one of the studio's selected catalogue or purchase your own. <u>If ordering from a catalogue</u>, <u>PARENTS are responsible for writing style #, colour, and size chosen for dancer on the order form.</u> (Take care when placing your order, as you are responsible for any errors you make.) Please include all accessories you wish to purchase with your costume (ie. hairpiece, gloves, hat, tutu, etc.) *All alterations are at the dancers expense.*

The choreographer has final approval on all costume designs and will decide all group costumes.

You can expect to pay an average of \$150 - \$250 for a group costume.

Summer Intensive Workshop Audition Fees:

All competitive students MUST attend the studio for a **THREE-DAY Summer** Intensive Workshop Audition taking place Aug 20th -22nd, 2024 \$325.00/dancer. This is non-refundable.

Boundless Team Wear:

Show your BDS PRIDE!

All competitive students will be required to purchase an official competitive team jacket and wear it at all BDS competitive team events. Other clothing options will be available to purchase as well.

Outside Choreography:

Outside choreography is a decision made by Miss Jen, and dancers/families will be approached with that offer. Please note that the fee for outside choreography will most likely be more expensive than our regular rate. Cleaning of the routine will be offered at an additional fee, depending on studio and staff availability. Outside choreography requires an *extra* level of commitment as the routine will be taught in a short time frame.

General Information

Competitions:

The studio will participate in three (3) competitions this year. It is understood that once you have commitment to a solo, duet or group, you are agreeing to participate in all three studio competitions. Every competition number (solos, duets, groups, etc.) will be entered in all three studio events unless otherwise stated or approved by instructors and Miss Jen.

If you cannot commit to all three (3) competitions, please do not consider yourself for the competitive program.

An additional competition may be offered at an additional fee.

Music:

Prior to the first rehearsal, students are required to supply 2 choices of music for their solos, duos & trios. During the first rehearsal, the choreographer and students will finalize the music choice. All music for groups is chosen only by the choreographer.

Every student participating in a group is strongly encouraged to practice their routines with music. Please ensure you have a copy of all of your group music.

Scheduling Private Lessons:

Competition private lessons will run during the week if there is time available, otherwise the majority of lessons will run on the weekend. All schedules are set by the teachers – we do our best to accommodate but cannot work around <u>individual</u> <u>schedules</u>.

Schedules:

October—December will be given out the last week of September. January—March will be given out prior to Christmas Break.

Cancellation Policy:

If for any reason you are unable to attend your private lesson, we ask that you find someone to swap times with or take your place. If you cannot find anyone to swap, there is a fee of \$50 and must be paid to the office prior to the next scheduled rehearsal. We ask that you respect the instructor's availability, as there is limited amount of time and space to do competition choreography. Commitment is required when agreeing to taking on extra competition work.
